

**Articles of Incorporation**

Pursuant to the provision of the Nonprofit Corporation Act of this state, the undersigned incorporators hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

**Article 1**

The name of this corporation is Linux Users Group In Princeton, Inc

**Article 3**

The purpose of the Corporation is to operate as an educational organization, as is provided for in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, for the sole purpose of educating the public about computers, computing devices, and software systems, including both application and operating systems; and particularly Linux and Open Source Operating Systems and Software. Such education is undertaken solely for the purposes of improving or developing the capabilities of the public, as well as the instruction of the public on subjects useful to individuals and beneficial to the community.

The activities of the Corporation, which shall be undertaken in furtherance of its educational purpose, shall be, but are not limited to, conducting public discussion groups, forums, panels, lectures, technical presentations, and other similar programs, as well as publication of such information, provision and maintenance of equipment, documents, materials, and other valuable intellectual and material properties in the furtherance of said educational purpose.

The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

## Article 7

The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications and obligations of members of this corporation are as follows: The membership provisions shall be stated in the Bylaws of this corporation.

## Article 8

Additional provisions:

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501 (h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the internal Revenue Code.
